- Each Restricted Stock Unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Company's Class A Common Stock.
- On November 28, 2022, the Reporting Person was granted 37,700 Restricted Stock Units, one third of which vested on the first anniversary of the date of grant and the remaining shares vest in eight equal quarterly installments beginning on February 28, 2024.
- On November 28, 2023, the Reporting Person was granted 68,767 Restricted Stock Units, one third of which vested on the first anniversary of the date of grant and the remaining shares vest in eight equal quarterly installments beginning on February 28, 2025.
- On November 28, 2024, the Reporting Person was granted 74,040 Restricted Stock Units, one third of which vest on the first anniversary of the date of grant and the remaining shares will vest in eight equal quarterly installments beginning on February 28, 2026.
- On May 30, 2023, the Reporting Person was granted 127,226 Restricted Stock Units, one third of which vested on the first anniversary of the date of grant and the remaining shares vest in eight equal quarterly
